PMI Southwest Missouri Chapter is now receiving member applications (i.e., peer and self-nominations) for the following 2018-2019 Board positions.

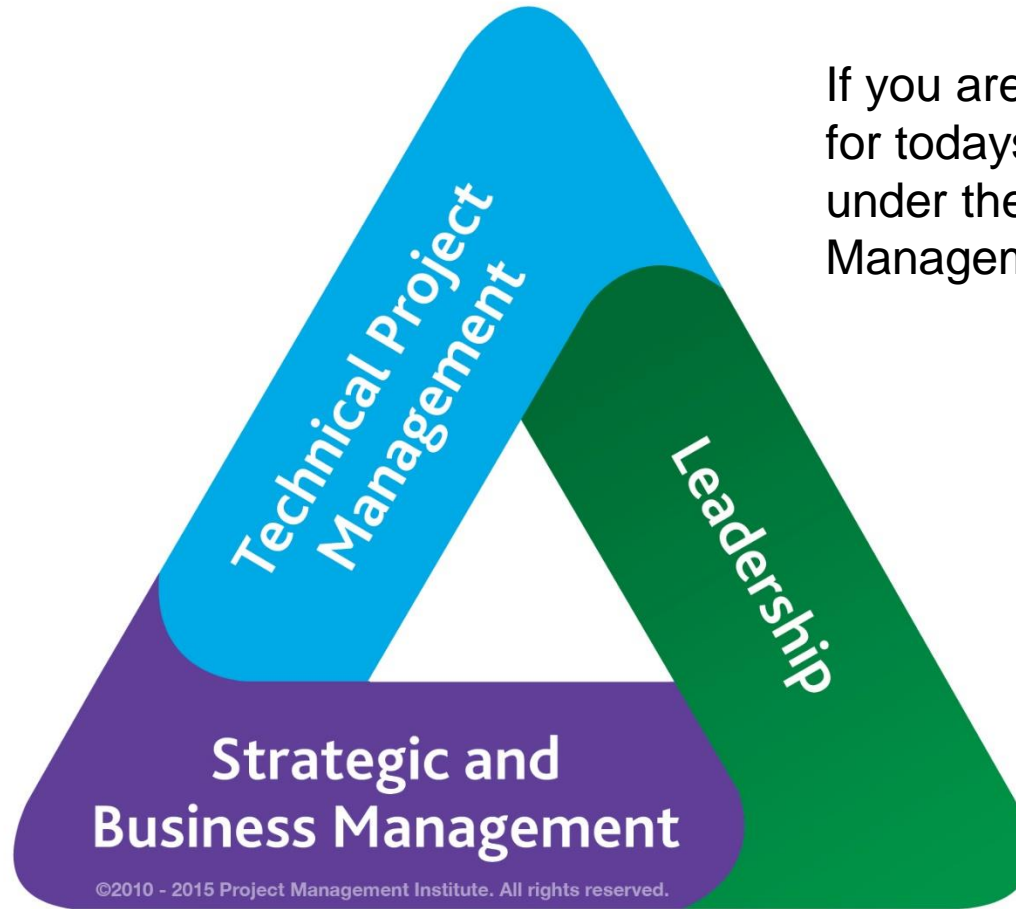
## Open positions
